ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

The ICAR-National Research centre on Mithun was established in June 1988 in the state of Nagaland under the aegis of Indian Council of Agricultural Research to provide impetus on the research work on Mithun (*Bos frontalis*). This Institute has been playing a key role in conservation, breeding and health management of this magnificent species. It is the only Institute in the world dedicated to research in Mithun. The campuses of the institute are situated at Medziphema (Dimapur district) and Porba (Phek district) Nagaland. The Jharnapani campus is 25 Km away from the Dimapur railway station and the Porba campus is 150KM away from the Dimapur railway station. The Institute is maintaining two Mithun farms, one at Jharnapani and other at Porba. The Jharnapani farm comprising of 62.5 acre land is located between 25.45° East longitude and 93.53° North latitude, about 300m above the mean sea level. The Porba farm comprising of 230.76 acre land is located between 94.20° East longitude and 24.53° North latitude, about 2133m above the mean sea level.

COURSE BACKGROUND

Animal Husbandry in India is an integral and interwoven part of agriculture since time immemorial and plays an important role in the rural economy. It is closely interlinked with the socio-economic fabrics of the rural society. Development of livestock sector, more particularly dairy sector has been receiving significant priority in India. Dairying has been proved to be a major source of income and employment of the rural masses. Besides income and employment, small scale dairy farming provides nutritional security to the rural people. The livestock sector has a special significance in the areas having low agriculture income and poor resource endowment. The dairy sector in particular provides nutritional security to the rural people.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This model training course is designed for State Veterinary Officers of North-Eastern Hill states of India and Subject Matter Specialists (SMS) working under State and ICAR KVKs in North-East region, researchers and teachers working in the National Agricultural Research System including state Agricultural / Veterinary universities and field diagnostic laboratories. The course is especially applicable to professionals involved in clinical and extension activities related to dairy animals.

The course objectives will be achieved through a combination of presentations, practical exercises and group discussions. More emphasis will be given to hands-on training involving scientific managerial practices relevant to popularization of small scale dairy development and improving clean milk production through genetic selection, scientific feeding, reproductive and health care management.

COURSE LOCATION

The course will be held at the ICAR-NRC on Mithun which is located at Medziphema block of Dimapur district, Nagaland.

TRAVEL, BOARDING & LODGING

No course fee will be charged for the course. The participants joining the course will be paid TA as per entitled class, but restricted to II AC Sleeper Class and DA for the journey period, provided they produce a certificate from the parent organization to the effect that they are not being paid any TA/DA. The participants will have to produce documentary evidence of traveling in the entitled class. However the TA/DA of the participant from ICAR, SAUS and KVKs will be borne by their respective organization/Institute.

Lodging and boarding for all outstation participants will be arranged free of cost in one of the guest houses of the institute for the period of their stay during the course.

The weather in late October will be cool, temperature ranging from 15 - 30°C. Light warm clothes may be needed during evening and night time.

REACHING NRC ON MITHUN

National Research Centre on Mithun is located in Jharnapani village, Medziphema block of district Dimapur, Nagaland, 25 km from Dimapur Railway station, on Dimapur- Kohima National Highway. It is well-connected by road as well as rail with the major cities.

A maximum of 25 participants would be selected on a first come-first served basis.
