Bid Security (refundable) of **Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One thousand only)** per animal should be submitted through Demand Draft favouring Director, ICAR-NRC on Mithun payable at State Bank of India, Medziphema Branch (code-06759). The Bid Security of the unsuccessful Bidders will be refunded after finalization of the Bid. The Bid security of the successful Bidders (s) will be adjusted with the Bid amount.
- 6. The book value mentioned in the list is minimum reserve price. Bidding below the minimum reserve value will not be acceptable.
